



What is EndNote Web?

EndNote Web is a bibliographic management product on the Web. With an EndNote Web account, users can manage references, cite references in papers and create bibliographies. EndNote Web is an ideal Web-service for existing EndNote users and an entree for students requiring a basic bibliographic research and formatting solution.

EndNote Web searches ISI Web of Knowledge, PubMed and hundreds of online library catalogs to help users build their personal reference collections easily. EndNote Web also provides direct record transfer from ISI Web of Knowledge products with integrated linking to the latest "Times Cited" and related records information.

Each EndNote Web library can store thousands of records and create bibliographies in over 1,300 publishing styles. The popular Cite While You Write™ is also available for anyone using Microsoft® Word® to create bibliographies instantly.

An EndNote Web subscription serves as an essential resource for everyone on campus—from students to teaching faculty—and provides added benefits for EndNote® users with an online storage option when they are away from their desktop libraries. References can be transferred between EndNote Web and EndNote X easily and without the need to export and import files.

Why is EndNote Web available free of charge via ISI Web of Knowledge and with EndNote site licensees? How does this impact scholarly research?

EndNote Web is offered at no charge to Thomson Scientific Academic and Government subscribers and EndNote site licensees. Our institutional and end-user customers have expressed the need for more robust Web-based services to complement our content and desktop software solutions. Given the ways EndNote Web works with ISI Web of Knowledge and EndNote X, users can now move seamlessly between content and bibliographic tools to simplify their research. Can my institution subscribe to EndNote Web without a subscription to ISI Web of Knowledge or an EndNote site license?

Yes. Standalone pricing for EndNote Web is available. However, the greatest benefit to your users comes with the integrated solution. With subscriptions to all, users can take advantage of the dynamic links to "Times Cited" and related records as well as author searching in ISI Web of Knowledge from EndNote Web. EndNote X on the desktop can be used with EndNote Web whether purchased as a site license, or individually.

How is EndNote Web accessed?

To access EndNote Web, users within authorized organizations simply go to www.myendnoteweb.com. Users can also access it through their ISI Web of Knowledge personalization preferences.

Can my users migrate their RefWorks libraries into EndNote Web?

To export a copy of all or part of your RefWorks database do the following:
From the References or Tools menu select Export.
Select either All References or a specific Folder.
Under Export Format select the RefWorks Tagged Format
Click the Export to Text File button.
Follow your browser's instructions for viewing the file and be sure to save the file to your hard disk before closing.

To import your RefWorks data into EndNote Web do the following:
From the EndNote Web main menu select Import/Export.
From the Import/Export menu select Import References into your Web Library
Under "Select your file" click the browse button and select your export file from RefWorks.
Under "Select the type" click the down arrow and select RefWorks Import option.
Click the Import button to import the references.

How often is the EndNote Web data backed up?

EndNote Web servers are backed up nightly.
